

Helpful Hints for T.E.A.C.H. Applicants

Applying for a scholarship can be intimidating. T.E.A.C.H. is there to help! If you have any questions at all, do not hesitate to call our office. Completing your application is the first step toward your educational success.

Eligibility

- Eligibility requirements for T.E.A.C.H. are not negotiable. Make sure you read and understand the requirements before you apply. If you have questions about eligibility, please call us.

The Application

- There are a few different applications available for T.E.A.C.H. because there are a variety of scholarship models. If you are not sure which you should choose, please call us.
- Incomplete applications may delay your award. Make sure you fill out each section of the application.
- Income verification for ALL household income MUST be included with the application, e.g., a pay stub. T.E.A.C.H. awards are not income based, but we must verify that each applicant's income meets eligibility requirements.
- Applicants also are encouraged to apply for Financial Aid. If T.E.A.C.H. is not the right option for you. It's important for all students to be aware of the methods of financing that are available.
- Turn in applications at least six weeks prior to the semester you want to begin classes.

We do not give out information regarding your specific position on the waiting list, however we welcome your phone calls if you have questions. You will be awarded when and if funding becomes available.
